Save \$1, Earn \$3 with IDA

What's an IDA?

A matched savings program to help low/moderate income individuals build wealth and acquire assets.

How does it work?

- Save \$2,000 over 6 months to three years.
- Attend financial education, homebuyer education and credit counseling at the Portland Housing Center.
- Earn up to a \$6,000 match for down payment/closing costs.

Who is eligible?

- Those earning 80% of the median income or less
- At least 18 years of age
- Have their own valid social security number
- Complete 4-week Financial Fitness class
- Complete credit counseling
- Complete Homebuyer Education
- Meet program asset requirements
- Demonstrate ability to save
- Ability to make monthly savings deposits
